## President's message to the membership:

I have only recently learned that the Jackson Open held in January did not require MCA membership. This was a very great disappointment to me and to other MCA officials. The event was publicized and reported in the Journal.

The only way the MCA has to raise the funds for the Journal is through collection of membership dues. Few players join or renew except in connection with tournament activity. Through the first seven months of the chess year there have been no events in the entire state that required MCA membership except those held in Starkville. The MCA simply cannot continue to finance the Journal under such circumstances.

It is to be hoped that organizers in Jackson, Greenville, and Clarksdale elect to hold at least one MCA (and Sweepstakes) event before the state championship in the fall. Events in still other cities would also be most welcome! What about this, Hernando?

At the business meeting in Hattiesburg, I shall propose that the entry fee for the state championship tournament be, after the 1981 event, \$60. Half of this will go into the prize fund and the other half into the treasury to finance the Journal.

I shall further propose that players receive an entry fee credit of \$2 for each game played in MCA events during the chess year beginning after the previous state tournament. Credit events must be open to all MCA members, must require MCA membership, must be USCF-rated, and must be announced and reported in the Journal.

Under this system a player who plays in 3 five-rounders during the year would be credited with \$30 and would pay an entry fee of \$30 for the state tourney. A player who plays 30 or more games in MCA events would enter the state tourney free.

This system would have the great added advantage of strongly encouraging organizers to make their tournaments MCA events as they would be saving money for any entrants who planned to enter the state tournament.

Those players who play in only the state tournament each year would be most welcome, along with their \$60 entry fee.

Special feature: Blitz Computer will be entered. No player will be required to play against Blitz. Blitz will not be eligible for prizes or titles.

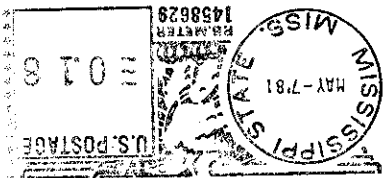
